At the Last Meeting...

On April 25, we were joined by Atlantic County Executive **Denny Levinson**. Denny gave a persuasive speech on his upcoming election. After sharing in some nostalgia for the old times as a member of our local city council, Denny got down to the bottom line of what his November campaign means to us in Atlantic County.

Nearly a year out from the election, the dirty tricks machine of Ron Ruff's county democrats kicked into gear, perverting the intent of the Open Public Records Act (OPRA). They asked for every scrap of paper, every receipt Denny produced, going fifteen plus years, back to his time on Northfield's governing body.
